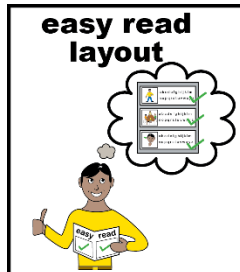
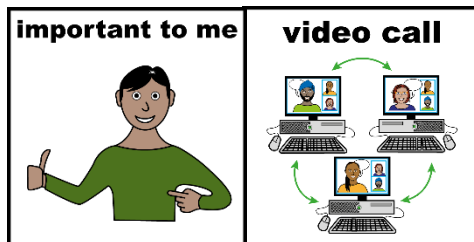


A digital disability? Easy-read blog

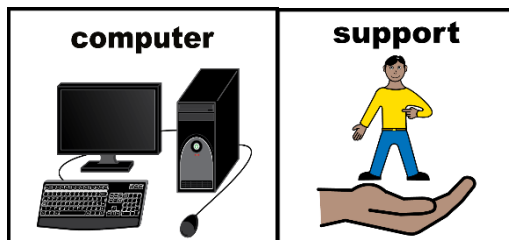

The writer thinks that this support should be easier to get.

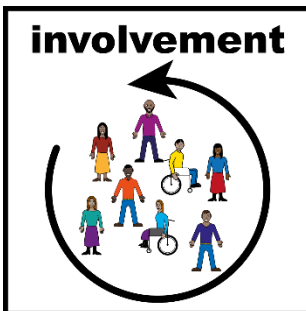
