

PROBLEM

Nationwide LGBTQ+ individuals face widening health inequalities that stem from feeling unseen and unheard in an increasingly underfunded health service. 1/8 LGBTQ+ individuals avoid seeking care for fear of discrimination. This lack of access only exacerbates poorer engagement and worsening community health outcomes both now and in the future, with those at the intersection of identities bearing the greatest weight of these challenges.

SOLUTION

LVNDR Health is an LGBTQ+ community-led platform offering sexual healthcare and wellbeing services designed and enabled by LGBTQ+ clinicians to deliver remote care through an app. This currently includes at-home PrEP test monitoring, remote consultation with LGBTQ+ clinicians, and PrEP delivery.


SUCSESSES AND IMPACT

- This year, LVNDR employed 8+ new LGBTQ+ hires across phenomenal organisations (GSTT, Headspace, Mastercard, Deloitte).
- LVNDR Health has received its CQC approval, which includes developing a comprehensive set of completely gender inclusive policies and procedures for our LGBTQ+ users and team members.
- LVNDR Health has successfully won its first NHS tender in partnership with an NHS London Trust as they look to deliver their novel LGBTQ+ wellbeing service in 2023.
